- 1. All members, parents and carers are listened to and help to influence strategies and approaches to prevent, report and respond to incidents of bullying.
- 2. All members are included, valued and participate fully in all aspects of training.
- 3. All members are role models to others within the club in how they treat others.
- 4. All discriminatory language is taken seriously and is challenged.
- 5. Everyone is an individual. Differences in all members are actively and visibly celebrated and welcomed. The beauty of Martial Arts training is that you mould the techniques to fit the individual, not the other way around.
- 6. All members and instructors understand what bullying is and how to both respond to and prevent it.
- 7. All members, parents and carers are acknowledged, believed and taken seriously when reporting incidents of bullying.
- 8. All members, parents and carers understand how to report incidents of bullying.
- 9. All incidents of bullying are quickly responded to.
