Senior Honours

Grand-Master Andrew Davies, the president of our governing body (UK Chung Do Kwan Taekwondo) and Master Evans and Master James's original instructor, has been awarded a 9th Dan black belt, the highest rank possible, by one of the original founders of Taekwondo, Supreme Grand-Master Kim Bok Man. This is the first time GM Kim has promoted a non-Korean national to this rank.

As part of Grand-Master Davies's promotion, he has been given the opportunity to recommend a select few senior masters for promotion and full recognition in Korea. This honour can only be given to those with an unbroken training record and the necessary skills. Master Evans is proud to be part of this select group and has been promoted to 7th Dan, and will be awarded his certificate in an official presentation in November.

Weapons Training

UK Chun Do Kwan Taekwondo have started to adopt a number of Supreme Grand-Master Kim's more traditional training elements, including training in traditional weapons. In my opinion, some of these weapons techniques are not relevant to modern day training or are purely for show. However, some weapons work is still relevant, whether that is as a practical weapon or related to the empty hand techniques. To this end, I will be starting to introduce some sword, 4' staff and short stick training into our programme.
